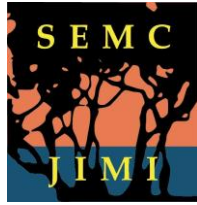


PETER S. LAPAGLIA JIMI SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Southeastern Museums Conference (SEMC) and the Jekyll Island Management Institute (JIMI) are pleased to award the annual Peter S. LaPaglia Scholarship for JIMI 2022, to be held January 18 - 25, 2022. The scholarship is for tuition only.

The recipient will be responsible for all travel and lodging costs. **In addition, the recipient will be required to write an article on his/her JIMI experience to be included in the SEMC newsletter following JIMI.**

SEMC and JIMI cordially invite you to submit your application for this scholarship.

Instructions: Include a copy of this scholarship application with the JIMI 2022 application packet. The deadline for submitting all of these materials is midnight, October 31, 2021.

Criteria: This scholarship is open to all museum personnel having 5-10 years experience and demonstrating involvement with a museum professional organization (state, regional, or national). The applicant must be a member of SEMC or, if not working in the southeast, be a member of another regional museum association.

Notification: All applications will be reviewed by the JIMI Committee, and all applicants will receive notification of the committee's decisions in November.
